Why the RehApp?

- Rehabilitation resources are scarce
- Rehabilitation services in many countries are not available nor easily accessible
- The situation in some countries is getting worse
- Serious brain-drain and skills-drain of rehabilitation staff
- Fieldworkers are usually very poorly trained

Why the RehApp?

"We should construct a viable kind of CBR, for people with disabilities in the economically poorest 2 billion, based on the fact that they hardly even have access to PHC or primary schooling; they and their families could benefit from acquiring basic knowledge and skills with which they could make an easier life with their impairment."




