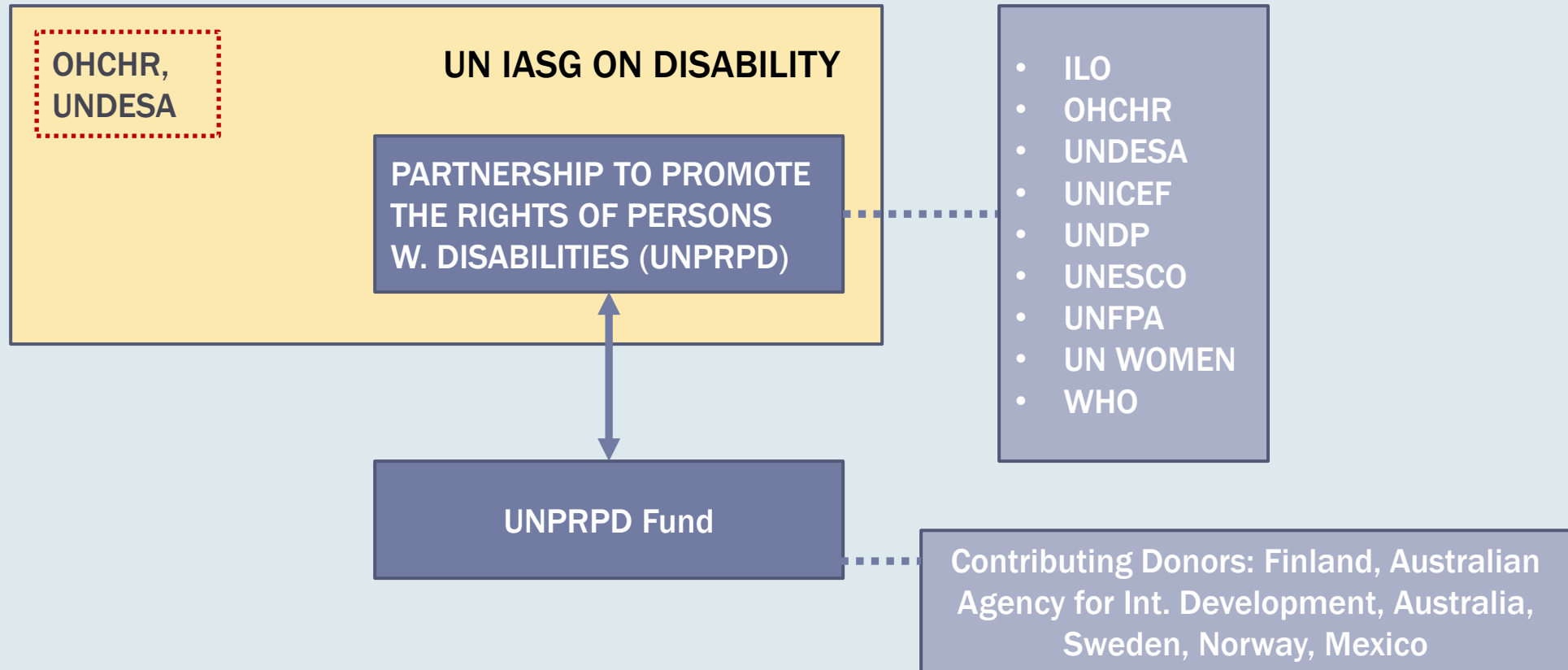

UN RESPONSE TO DISABILITY



OVERALL OBJECTIVE

To develop the capacities of national stakeholders, particularly governments and organizations of persons with disabilities, for the effective implementation of the CRPD, including through promoting disability-inclusive internationally agreed development goals.

- 1 Enabling legislation and policy frameworks
- 2 Empowering cultural norms

- 7 Access to rehabilitation and habilitation, including assistive technology
- 8 Adequate data and evidence

ALLOCATION OF RESOURCES

■ **Scope of funding**

- Mainly country level
- Support work funded at regional and global level too

■ **Fund recipients**

- Principal recipients are the Fund Participating UN Organizations
- Typically, but not exclusively, for joint programmes
- Aid-effective programming
