An article introducing the main topic should have approximately 24'000, other articles 16'000 letters (including spaces and references). Please use the counting system of your word processor.

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A summary text of 5-7 lines should be added to your article.

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Please let us know, while entering the article, which sentence in your article should be highlighted as a highlight sentence. The highlight sentence should be able to stand on its own and have a significant meaning in the text.

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Tables should be used from the word processor (the program you are using) and not from any other source. If possible, send charts and pictures in a separate file. With charts, please use WMF, EMF or JPEG/JPG formats. Pictures should be sent in JPG format, if the picture is very small, please use TIFF format in order to avoid losses. We don't ask for any special picture size (dpi etc.) because it requires specific know-how. However, pictures should be sent in the best available resolution. In case of scanning, please use 200 dpi.

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
